City of Kingston Central Enrolment Process – Farm Road Pre-School

- 2. Select your preferred kindergartens. You will be asked to nominate 3 preferred kindergartens in order of preference.
- 3. Submit your application along with the enrolment fee (as specified on the application form) online or in person to the City of Kingston.
- 4. The City of Kingston will acknowledge receipt of your application within 1 month of receiving the application.
- 5. The City of Kingston will use 6 levels of criteria to allocate children to the Funded Kindergartens.
- 6. The Farm Road Pre-School advises the City of Kingston how many positions are available to be offered.
- 7. Kindergarten allocations commence mid-July each year. The City of Kingston advises the Farm Rd Pre-School enrolment officer of the offers to be made initially to those who have nominated Farm Rd Pre-School as a 1st preference.
- 8. The Farm Rd Pre-School enrolment officer sends out letters of offer to those who have been allocated a position.
- 9. Families have the opportunity to accept and decline a position. If a position is declined, the City of Kingston advises the enrolment officer of the next family on the Farm Road Pre- School waiting list.
- 10. Offers are made until all available positions are filled.
